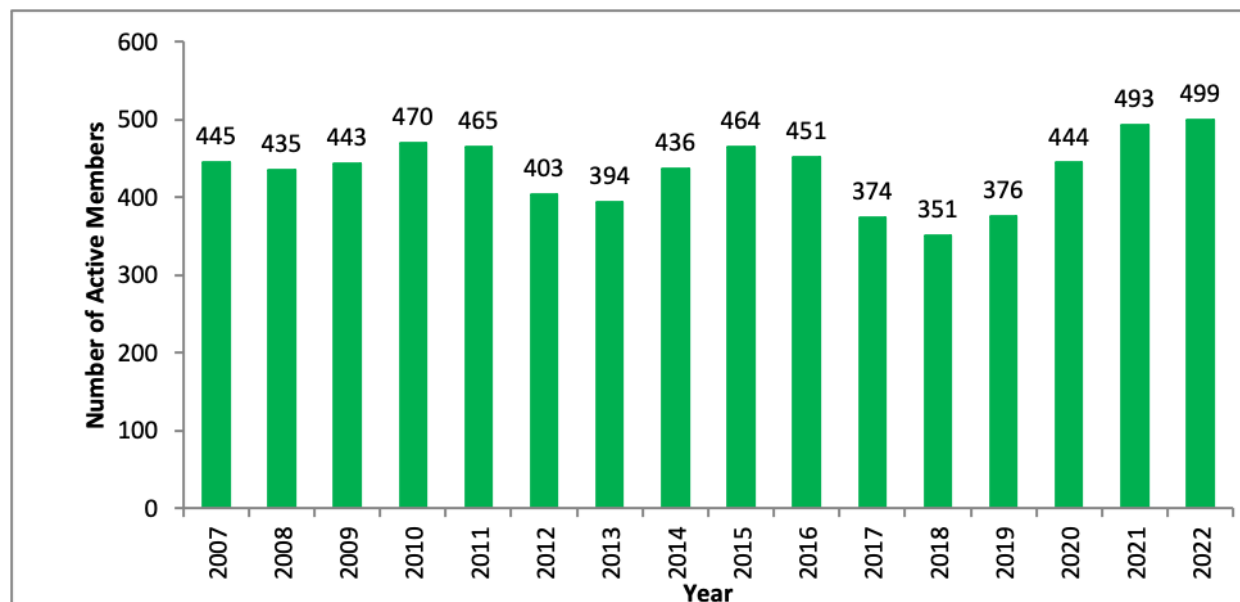


Fig 1 Total membership by year

Members receiving a physical copy of the EJP by post were 26% (table 2). This percentage is held up by other categories as the EJP by post % in the ordinary-membership-with-journal category has dropped from 20 to 17% since 2019. Membership breakdown.

Membership percentages in each category stayed remarkably consistent from 2021 to 2022 (table 2). Student membership has risen slightly from 32 to 33 % but considering the disruptions to teaching over the last few years this has held up well.
